Lead Engineer: \$0.50/hour over Class I.

OVERTIME**RATE:**

1 1/2 for hours worked in excess of 8 hour day, Monday thru Friday and all hours on Saturday (except for make-up days and shift work). Double for all hours worked Sunday and Holidays. Veterans' Day is celebrated on the day after Thanksgiving.
